2010 MAIS Cross Country State Championship

The 2010 MAIS Cross Country State Championship was held at Choctaw Trails in Clinton on Monday, October 25. Our Cougars took the top 5 spots to score a perfect 15 points in winning their 4th consecutive AA State Championship. The Cougars posted a best Overall average time of 19:26 and would have also won the AAA Championship.

Jon Luke Watts ran 17:49 to take the Overall Individual Championship and remains undefeated in MAIS competition this season. Tyler Berry finished 2nd with a personal record 18:36.
